**Love146** (New Haven, CT | Charlotte, NC | United Kingdom) - Provides transformative services, develops outcome-focused solutions and challenges society's response to the ongoing exploitation of children. Love146 also provides an interactive child trafficking and exploitation prevention curriculum designed to provide youth with information and skills that inspires them to make safe choices.

**Not for Sale** (Emeryville, CA) - Works to provide vital direct resources to trafficked people. Partners with local experts to understand the causes of slavery, investigates local economies to discover where the cycle might be broken, works with local entrepreneurs to create projects that provide education, empowerment, income.

**Polaris Project** (Washington, DC) - Serves victims and survivors through the National Human Trafficking Hotline, builds datasets that illuminates how human trafficking really works, in real time, and turns knowledge into targeted systems-level strategies to disrupt and prevent human trafficking.

**Selah Freedom** (Sarasota, FL & Chicago Ridge, IL) – provides a residential program for survivors of sex trafficking. Call their Survivor Intake Phone Number at 888-837-3363.

**The Night Ministry** (Chicago, IL) - Provides housing, health care and human connection to members of the community who are struggling with poverty or homelessness.
